A once-in-a-lifetime opportunity – Ride for your Country

Must be 11 years of age as at 20 October 2018

QUALIFICATION

- Riders nominate to be considered for the Junior Test Team by entering the "Qualifier" **event fee is \$25.**
- You must enter Mighty 11's and/or Age Class (as per the entry form, published entry fees will apply)
- Riders enter and compete in their normal 20" race class (motos only counted), Riders can enter the Mighty 11's event (motos only counted), Test Team motos are counted (semi finals and finals will not count)
- We look for the fastest single lap time across all motos from riders who have nominated for the Qualifier
- The riders (Boys and Girls) with the fastest single lap time will be offered a place in the Trans Tasman Test Team to race in New Zealand in October 2018

NEW ZEALAND LEG

- Male and Female Test Teams will spend 10 days in New Zealand and will compete against the New Zealand teams in the Trans Tasman Test Team race event held during the BMXNZ North Island Titles
- This is a great cultural experience for rider
- It is specialised team racing
- Mum and Dad... we will be taking your child to NZ for a week, your child will need to be somewhat self-sufficient, if this is not them, this event may not be for them

1. Qualification Criteria

You Must

- Be an Australian Citizen
- Hold a current BMXA licence and
- Be 11 years of age on 20 October 2018

2. Test Team Rider and Parent Responsibilities

It is expected that each rider who earns and accepts a position on the June Test Team will:

- Rider family to make a financial contribution of \$950 per rider (payable to BMXNSW)
- Compete in both the Test Team and Mighty 11's event (entry fees will be paid by BMXNSW) held during the NZ North Island Titles October 2018
- Attend all organised team building training events prior to the event on notified dates to be advised
- Be able to travel to NZ for a week with the team in October 2018
- Participate in all team activities while in NZ. Note that riders are billeted with NZ families and are away from

4. Junior Trans Tasman Test Team Event (October 2018)

The NZ North Island Titles combines the following events (all events run together over the weekend):

- the NZ North Island Titles (open race meeting)
- the Trans Tasman Test Team Event (4 Aus v 4 NZ boys and 4 Aus v 4 NZ Girls over 5 motos)
- the Mighty 11's event (a prestigious race for age-on-on-day 11 year olds from across the country and New Zealand)

5. Team Merchandise

- Test Team Riders will be presented with Team uniforms which will include: Team Jersey, Swap Jersey, Race Pants, 3 x Polo Shirts, 1 x Jacket, 1 x Hoodie and Race Plate. Riders are required to race in their team Jersey, and wear their Polo shirts at team activities (ie outings and Dinner etc).
