If rider not listed then they are not entered.

If you do not have your own transponder then pay the higher fee. **If you pay the wrong fee your entry will not be accepted.**

**Note 3: rules for 17+ Pro Classes – Pro Sections on any tracks will be mandatory (ARB 030)**

You can only ride one 20" class at any event. Must be turning 17 (or older) in current year. “A Pro” riders require logbooks. Cannot ride up into this class.
