Rules for Superclass

1. "Superclass": Riders must be turning 14 years of age or older (*this is Pro Class racing*)
2. One entry puts rider in both day's racing
3. Prizemoney split evenly across both days
4. Saturday event prizemoney only. Sunday event prizemoney and State Championship
5. "A" riders require logbooks
6. Pro sections mandatory for Superclass

Regulations (this is part of the entry form)

Alcohol: is banned for everyone within track environs.

Coaching: Thursday 29 September 9.00am to 5.00pm for State Coaching Clinics – book places via State website. Track is closed to all riders except those involved in coaching clinics.

Drug Testing: All entrants agree to submit to the standard Australian Drugs in Sport testing for the use of drugs. Random testing may occur.

Force Majeure: BMXNSW Inc, the Event Coordinator or the Board of Management shall not be responsible or liable to riders, parents, sponsors or any other party as a result of any failure to perform any of its obligations, if such failure results from circumstances beyond the control of such party.

Merchandise: Order via entry form. Merchandise will be available for collection at the track. Merchandise will not be sold at the event.

Number Plate: all riders will be provided with a competitor plate and number. This is only plate used.

Opening Ceremony: At the track 11.00am Saturday. All clubs/teams marshal in staging at 10.45am.

Parking: Gold coin donation.

Practice: times for all practice sessions over weekend will be promoted on website. **All riders must sign-on prior to practice** and have correct plate on their bike.

Sprocket Party: Friday 30 September immediately following Sprocket Coaching Clinic (for Sprockets attending the Clinic only).

State Series Presentation: at end of practice each morning for classes running on that day. Riders to assemble in staging.

State Titles Presentation: at track end of each day's racing. All riders must wear race jerseys. Clubs to take uncollected trophies – NSW won't send trophies out after event.

Qualification: See BMXNSW website. If you have not qualified your entry will not be accepted except via "Exceptional Circumstances" process.

Refunds: no refunds will be given without medical proof. No refunds at all after registration closes. Medical Certificate to be supplied within one week of event or refund forfeited. Amount of refund will take into consideration Rider Levies and costs associated with the entry package.

Registration: Riders are required to register at the event by 9.30am on the Saturday for Saturday racing and 9.00am on the Sunday for Sunday racing. Only signed-on riders included in moto draw (*sign on once only*).

Scrutineering: held at random during the event.

Smoking: This is a strictly non-smoking event.

Sprockets: are participation only and ride 4 motos. All Sprockets are strongly urged to attend the Sprocket coaching clinic at the Titles (details released on separate Sprocket Coaching Clinic form). There will also be a Sprocket Party for all Sprockets involved in State Clinic after coaching.

Supplementary Regulations: Will be posted on BMXNSW website prior to event.

Teams (Club and Corporate): Pick up forms at event.

Track: Track closed from Thursday 5.00am except for official use each day.
