<i>Who</i>	Australian riders who will be 11 years of age in October this year	NSW riders looking for racing time on the State Titles Track	Male: 4 x Aus, 4 x NZ Female: 4 x Aus, 4 x NZ	All-in girls and boys from both Australia and New Zealand who are aged 11 years on this day (age on day event) ... includes riders who are also in the Junior Test Team from both countries
<i>What</i>	Racing for a place in the Australian Junior Test Team to travel to NZ in October for return leg of Junior Test Times taken from 20" age, M11 and JTT motos only	Standard BMXNSW racing	5 motos (point only) Country v Country – separate competition for male and female teams	Racing to become the “Mighty 11” for 2016 (the fastest 11-year-old in Aus/NZ) Normal racing “except” that the quarters/semis are points-based instead of elimination format – so points all the way to work out the best 8 riders for the final
<i>Why</i>	BMXNSW need to find 8 riders (4 x male, 4 x female) to make up NZ leg of Junior Test – obviously raced in NZ in October	Why not?	Bragging rights between Australia and New Zealand on who has the best team of 11-year olds in both boys and girls	Event has long tradition extending way back into folklore (with practically no-one remembering the details) – so it’s just become a “tradition” anyway
